Study this map and choose your route, then calculate speeds and distances, solving the tasks on the next page!

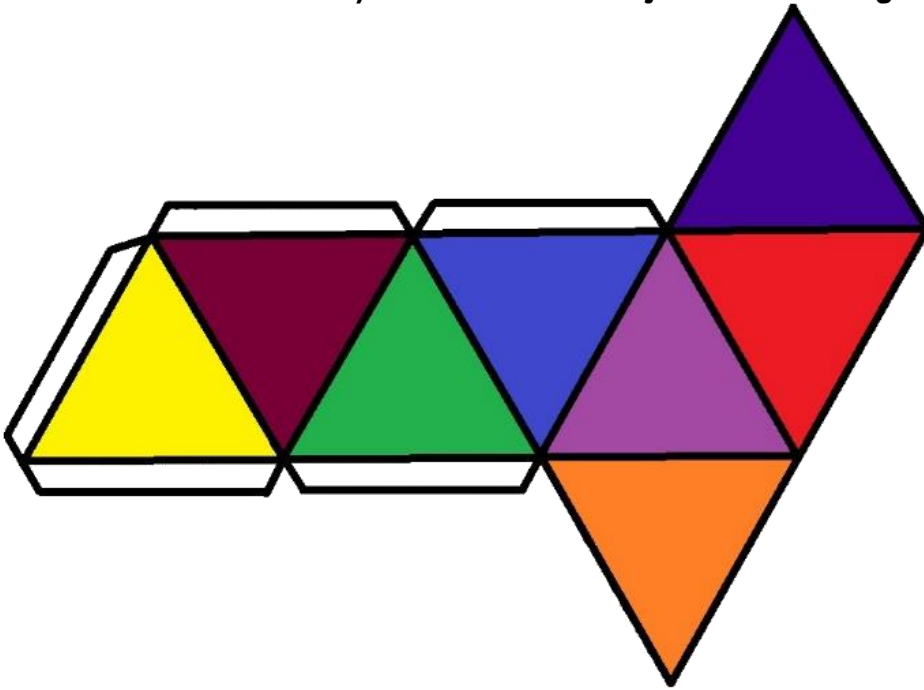


Distance of Santander (3) and San Sebastian (1) is 198 km



Calculate your pilgrim route!

Cut out and glue together this octahedral die!
 Roll the die to find out your route (the routes are signed
 with different colours) and find out your starting city!



Calculate the distance between your starting point and
 Santiago de Compostela, and the total distance to walk/ride
 on your way!

Plan your places to stop!

Choose a means of transport (e.g. riding a bike, walking, riding
 a horse, wheelchair etc.)! Find out the velocity of this means
 and calculate times between the planned stops.

 of the trip and your starting point
