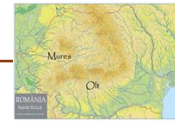

Oh, how happy Olt was! He forgot his weariness, ran to the bosom of the Danube, and was no longer angry with the Mures, but kissed him with joy.

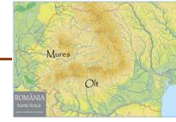
