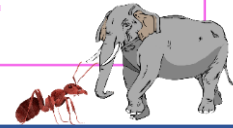


SULTAN OF ELEPHANTS AND GIMPY RED BEARDED ANT

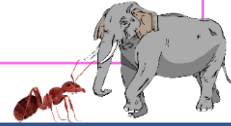
