



Jumping Jack

You can easily make your own Pumuckl as a jumping jack. Suitable as a decoration for the classroom, for the children's room or as a gift for younger siblings: the cute hanger will cheer everyone up.

You need:

- Plywood, DIN A/4
- Sandpaper
- Drill
- Acrylic paints
- 50-60cm string, wooden bead
- 4 screws with nuts



This is how it's done:

- Print out the craft template to a piece of plywood.
- Saw out the body parts along the lines and sand down the edges.
- Paint the parts with acrylic paints.
- Drill out the pre-drawn holes. (There are two different sizes!)
- Attach the legs and arms with screws.
- Tie the arms and legs together with shorter threads. Use the smaller holes for this.
- Tie the drawstring to the cross-connections and attach a wooden bead to the bottom end.
- Thread another string through the hole on the head to hang it up.
