Pencil holder made from tin can

You will need:

- Tin can
- Wrapping paper or napkin
- Pair of scissors
- Glue
- Possibly self-adhesive film
- Acrylic paint
- Ready to use Pumuckl figure made from wool

This is how it's done:

- Remove the label from the tin and wash it well. Be careful with the sharp cut edges.
- Cut the napkin or wrapping paper to size. The width of the cut paper corresponds to the circumference of the tin.
- Stick the cut paper around the tin.
- Also cut the self-adhesive film to size and stick it around the tin.
- If you don't like working with wrapping paper or napkins, paint your tin in your favourite colour.
- Stick your Pumuckl figure onto the tin as if he had just got stuck on the glue pot.





Pencil holder made from plastic bottles

You will need:

- Plastic bottle
- Pair of scissors
- Acrylic paint
- Marker
- Old newspaper
- Gloves



This is how it's done:

- First cut off the neck of the bottle.
- Think about which figure you like and draw it on the bottle (work carefully! There are two figures on the template!)
- Once the outer lines have been cut out, you can start painting
- Once the colour has dried well, you can draw on the facial cast of features with the permanent marker
- Now you can fill your new pen holder with pens and pencils and place it on your desk
- Have fun creating!
