

Questions used in brainstorming technique in story creation:

1. Theme and Purpose of the Story

- What should this story tell?
- What will be the main theme (migration, solidarity, friendship, etc.)?
- What is the message the story wants to give to the reader?

2. Main Character and Other Characters

- Who will be the main character?
- What is the motivation and purpose of the main character?
- Who will be the side characters in the story and how will they contribute to the story?
- What will be the emotional state and development of the characters?

3. Event Structure

- How will the story begin, develop and conclude?
- What is the main conflict or problem?
- What important events will take place in the story?
- How will the solution be presented?

4. Time and Space

- In which time does the story take place (present, past, near future, etc.)?
- In which locations will the story take place (How will places such as home, harbor, exchange, school, etc. be depicted?)
- How will the locations reflect the emotional state of the characters?

5. Emotional and Cultural Dimension

- What emotions should the story evoke in the reader?
- How should Yana's trauma and difficulties be conveyed?
- How will the influence of different cultures (Ukraine and Turkey) be incorporated into the story?

6. Target Audience

- To whom is this story addressed (children, youth, adults?)?
- What should the target audience feel when reading the story?

7. Conclusion and Message

- What should the characters learn or how should they change at the end of the story?
- What lessons can readers learn at the end of the story?
- How can the story end in a hopeful and inspiring way?
